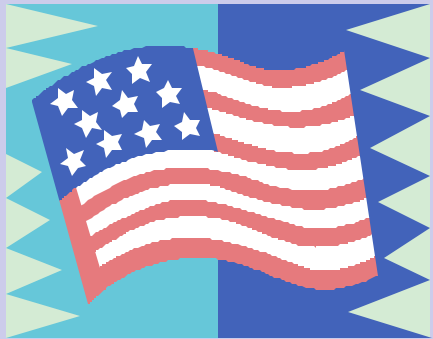
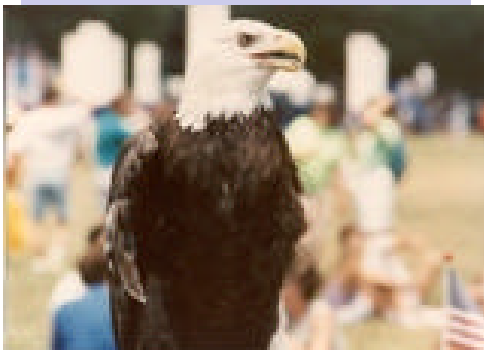

Financial Assistance:

CCVP offers emergency financial assistance to eligible veterans and their dependents, who are indigent or at risk of becoming indigent. Financial assistance is not an entitlement program.

Eligible veterans and their dependents may receive assistance with mortgage payments, rent, utility bills, and food on a case by case basis, subject to eligibility requirements.

Employment Services:

CCVP staff coordinate with the local employment office and Work Source to assist veterans in securing employment and services. Contact Ruben Ruelas at 509.665.3702 for more information.

Chelan County has served low income, homeless, disabled, and at risk veterans and their families for over 30 years. The CCVP is mandated by RCW 73.04.080 and is funded by Chelan County taxpayers.

Honorably discharged veterans who served in any branch of the US military may be eligible for services, subject to state residency requirements, length of service standards, and income guidelines. Spouses and minor children of veterans may also be eligible for various Chelan County Veterans services.
