***NOTICE OF ORDER REQUIRING IGNITION INTERLOCK
DEVICE***

You have either been convicted of a DUI or placed on Deferred Prosecution. As part of your court order, the judge is requiring that you be **prohibited from operating any vehicle that is not equipped with a functioning ignition interlock breath alcohol device**. Please observe the following:

- You shall not operate any motor vehicle unless you have a valid drivers license and liability insurance

FOR ANY DUI CONVICTION:

At the end of any period of drivers license suspension, revocation or denial for this specific offense, you shall only operate a motor vehicle equipped with a functioning ignition interlock breath alcohol device for:
NOTE: An occupational permit IS NOT a license reinstatement! The ignition interlock period does not begin until you fully reinstate your driving privileges.

One Year

FOR DEFERRED PROSECUTION:

You shall only operate a motor vehicle equipped with a functioning ignition interlock breath alcohol device for the initial period indicated. Be advised that Department of Licensing will be notified. Further, the Court can lift this restriction earlier based upon significant progress in treatment and other factors deemed significant by your probation officer.

- ***For 1st DUI Conviction ONLY:*** Within 30 days of your license reinstatement, you must do one of the following:

For Deferred Prosecution: Within 30 days of sentencing, you must do one of the following:

- Provide proof to your probation officer that you have had an ignition interlock device installed, or,
- Sign a document stating you do not intend to drive a motor vehicle and/or reinstate your driving privileges. (NOTE: Signing this document would result in serious consequences should you later drive. So don't sign it unless you mean it!)

NOTE: Failure to provide this proof or sign the statement will result in a probation violation notice being sent to the judge and could result in additional penalties.

- You will be required to pay the cost of installation and maintenance of the ignition interlock device
- You shall have the device installed by a Washington State Patrol certified vendor on any motor vehicle you will operate. On the reverse side of this form is a listing of vendors and phone numbers to call for the installation center nearest you.

- You shall not adjust, tamper with, remove, or circumvent (1) any ignition interlock breath alcohol device, (2) the wiring of any ignition interlock breath alcohol device, or (3) the ignition system of any vehicle equipped with an ignition interlock breath alcohol device.
- Give this form to the ignition interlock device installer.

TO IGNITION INTERLOCK VENDOR:

- The installer shall monitor any device installed at least once every sixty (60) days; notification of installation shall ONLY be reported to Probation Services as instructed below. Notice of any failures or tampering can be sent to the appropriate prosecuting authority, NOT probation services.
- The ignition interlock breath alcohol device shall have a setting Fail Level of .02 to prevent the motor vehicle from being started; rolling retests are required; horn is required.
