All voter registration applications, transfers from another county, and changes of address within Chelan County, submitted by mail or online, must be postmarked by Monday, October 10, 2016 or may be delivered to the Chelan County Auditor's Office no later than 5:00 p.m., Monday, October 10, 2016 to be eligible for the November 8, 2016 General Election.

Persons not already registered in Washington State may register in-person no later than Monday, October 31, 2016 at the Chelan County Auditor's Office, 350 Orondo Ave, Level 3, Wenatchee, Monday thru Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
