PROPOSITION NO. 1

AUTHORIZING REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVIES FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 1, Chelan County, Washington, adopted Resolution No. 2017-03 concerning a proposition to retain firefighters and hire seasonal wildland firefighters. This proposition would set the 2018 property tax levy rate at \$1.42 per \$1,000 of Assessed Valuation (from 1.37 per \$1,000 of Assessed Valuation in 2017) and allow an annual increase of up to 6% in the successive years between 2018 and 2022, never to exceed the statutory maximum of \$1.50 per thousand. The maximum allowable levy in 2022 (not greater than \$1.50) shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations under RCW 84.55.

Proposition No. 1

Levy Lid Lift

The Board of Chelan County Fire Protection District No. 3 adopted Resolution No. 2017-05 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.

This proposition authorizes the District to restore its regular property tax levy to \$ 1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed value to be assessed in 2017 and collected in 2018. The funds will maintain and improve fire protection and emergency medical services, maintain staffing, replace apparatus, equipment and facilities and provide for firefighter safety. The maximum allowable levy in 2017 shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.
