





Q3 Do you live in a known floodplain or an area that has been subject to flooding?







Q6 Is this your primary residence or is it your vacation/second home?





Q13 What would drive you to action in response to an emergency notification?







Q17 Which of the following incentives would encourage you to spend money to retrofit your home to protect against flood disasters? (Check all that apply)



Q18 When you moved into your home, did you consider the impact a potential flood could have on your home?



Q19 Was the presence of a flood hazard disclosed to you by a real estate agent, seller, or landlord before you purchased or moved into your home?







Q22 Do you support the regulation (restriction) of land uses within known, high risk, flood hazard areas?



Q23 What types of projects do you believe the Local, State or Federal government agencies should consider to reduce damage and disruption from flooding?










