Chelan County Natural Resource Department, on behalf of the Stemilt Partnership, has been working with a group of recreation stakeholders to plan for the future of recreation in the Stemilt and Squilchuck basins in a community-based effort to ensure the protection of water, wildlife, and

recreation opportunity in the Stemilt-Squilchuck Community Forest. You are invited to join us at the Malaga Fire Hall on March 21st as we present the draft recreation recommendations produced through a collaborative effort between Chelan County, WDFW, DNR, State Parks, recreation interest groups, irrigation districts, local citizens and landowners, and the Stemilt Partnership.

The Open House will begin with a presentation of the planning effort from approximately 6:00-6:30pm. Attendees will then have an opportunity to view recommendations, mingle with members of the planning group, and provide comments.
