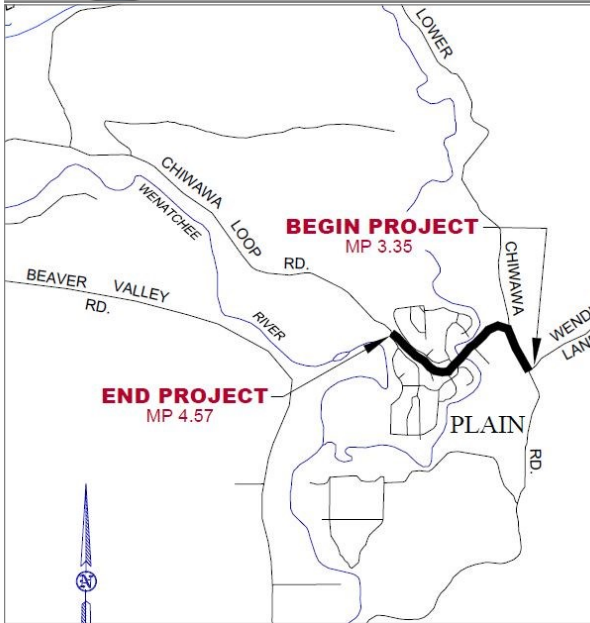


# CRP 675: Chiwawa Loop Road, Phase III

**Project Number:** County Road Project 675

**Project Length:** 1.44 miles

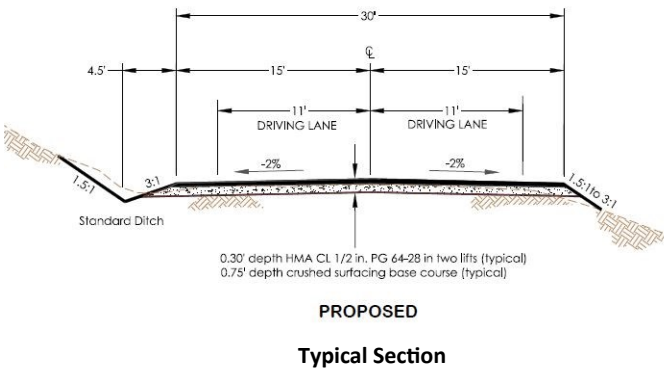
**Basis for Project:** Roadway Preservation

**Construction:** Summer 2017

**Project Description:** The primary purpose of this project is to reconstruct 1.44 miles along Chiwawa Loop Road (93300) from Wending Lane to Sumac Lane. The project will address a deteriorating pavement and roadway base by upgrading the structural integrity, which can be maintained at a low life cycle cost. In addition to a new roadway base and surfacing, this project will also widen the road from 22 feet to 30 feet, examine the need for drainage, replacement/addition of guardrail, construct fish passable drainage structure, improve roadway geometrics, and make improvements to the roadside and clear zone.

**Status:** Design is near complete. Right-of-way and temporary easement acquisition is underway.

**Traffic Impacts:** Travelers on Chiwawa Loop Road can expect to encounter one-lane flagger or pilot car controlled traffic through work zones with delays up to 20 minutes during construction Summer 2017.
