

CRP 694: So. Wenatchee Pedestrian Improvements, Phase II

Mission Street, & Terminal Avenue

Basis for Project: Safety/Non-Motorized Facilities Construction: June 19 through July 2017

<u>Project Description:</u> This area near Mission View Elementary experiences heavy traffic, especially during the morning peak period when students, parents, and staff are arriving at school. This second phase is intended to construct a pedestrian route without breaks from the City's termini at Crawford Street to Mission View Elementary School along Terminal Avenue with the installation of ADA approved curb ramps, sidewalks, and marked crosswalks. This project is funded with grant money from the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) and Safe Routes to Schools (SRTS). Based on the existing right-of-way constraints, the new 5-foot wide sidewalk facility will require purchase of right-of-way.


<u>Status</u>: Project has moved into the construction phase. Bianchi Construction was awarded the bid. Construction is to begin in June 19.

<u>Traffic Impacts:</u> During construction, travelers should expect flagger-controlled traffic with delays of up to 10 minutes. Crews will be working 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.
