



# CRP 697: Recessed Pavement Markers

## Various Routes

Project Basis: Replace missing & deteriorated RPMs Construction: August 2015

**Project Description:** The primary purpose of this project is to remove and replace the existing Recessed Pavement Markers (RPMs) on 5 routes in the county. Since these RPMs were originally installed, several routes have been or will be chip sealed. During the chip sealing operations the crews must remove the existing RPMs to ensure proper construction of the chip seal. Additionally, the existing RPMs that were not removed are approaching the end of their typical life span. This project will replace the remaining RPMs and reinstall the missing RPMs.

**Status:** Project was awarded to Northstar Enterprises with a low bid of \$59,200. Construction is set to start mid-August and will be complete in 10 working days.

**Traffic Impacts:** During construction travelers on the Chumstick Highway, Beaver Valley Road, Icicle Road, Sunset Highway, Stine Hill Road, Squilchuck Road, and the Malaga/Alcoa Highway should expect flagger-controlled traffic delays and rolling slowdowns.
