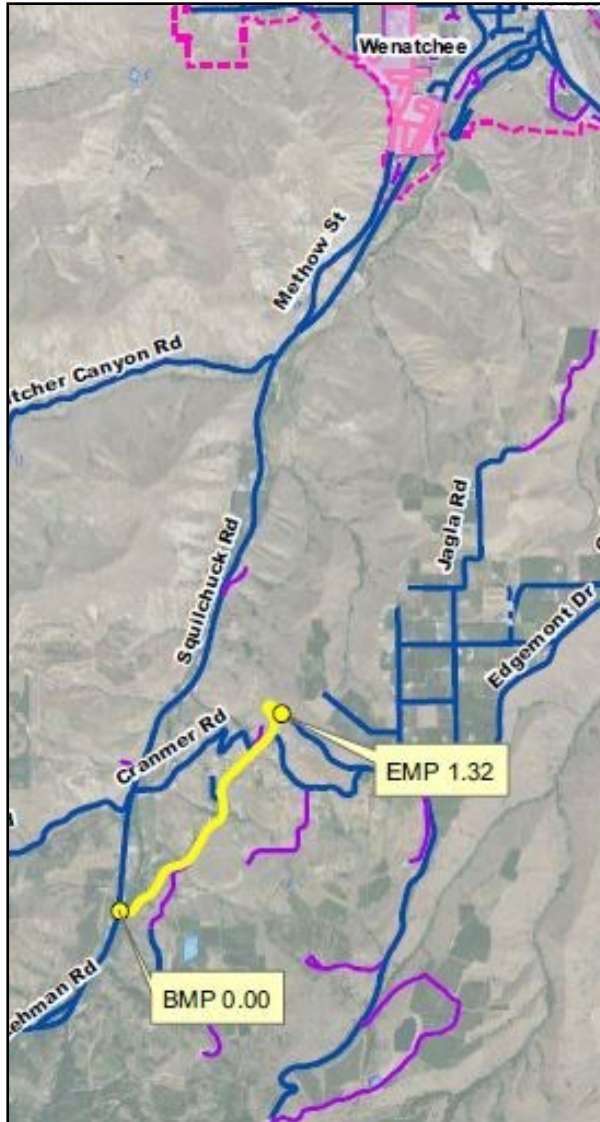


CRP 702 Wenatchee Heights Road Improvement

Project Number: County Road Project 702

Project Length: 1.32 miles

Basis for Project: Road rehabilitation

Construction: Summer 2021

Project Description: The primary purpose of this project is rehabilitate the roadway and maintain it at the least possible life cycle cost. This planned work consists of a HMA overlay to prevent further deterioration of the existing roadway, which falls below the level of minimal standards (42 to 70 rating). In addition to the pavement rehabilitation, the project will improve the pavement structure, investigate and mitigate the settlement/slide, replace deficient guardrail, and other safety improvements. The project will also upgrade the existing shoulders to 3 feet.

Status: Preliminary design is underway and is at about 30 percent. Cores completed September 2018. Construction has been moved to 2021.

Travel Impact: Construction has been moved to summer 2021. Preliminary construction scheduled to take 60 working days. During daylight hours, expect one-lane, flagger-controlled traffic with some delays.
