







Ingersoll Road Realignment (CRP 667)

STATUS: Major construction wrapped up on Thursday, June 7, 2012. County crews will return next week for some small finishing tasks.

The realigned road is open to traffic now.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County realigned Ingersoll Road because of a flood event in May of 2011. When Colockum Creek flooded over its banks, it caused a wash out of Ingersoll Road in several locations, leaving the road impassable.

The work required abandoning the existing roadway and constructing approximately 0.75-mile new roadway on a bench to the north and away from Colockum Creek.
