


CRP 675: Chiwawa Loop Road, Phase III

Project Vicinity Map


Project Number: County Road Project 675 Project Length: 1.44 miles

Basis for Project: Roadway Preservation Construction: June 5 to early October 2017

<u>Project Description</u>: The primary purpose of this project is to reconstruct 1.44 miles along Chiwawa Loop Road (93300) from Wending Lane to Sumac Lane. The project will address a deteriorating pavement and roadway base by upgrading the structural integrity, which can be maintained at a low life cycle cost. In addition to a new roadway base and surfacing, this project will also widen the road from 22 feet to 30 feet, examine the need for drainage, replacement/addition of guardrail, construct fish passable drainage structure, improve roadway geometrics, and make improvements to the roadside and clear zone.

<u>Status</u>: Project is under construction. Bid was awarded to Reece Construction Company. An open house on the project is scheduled for 4-6 p.m. on May 4 at Thousand Trails Resort.

<u>Traffic Impacts</u>: Travelers on Chiwawa Loop Road can expect to encounter one-lane flagger or pilot car controlled traffic through work zones with delays up to 20 minutes during Summer 2017.
