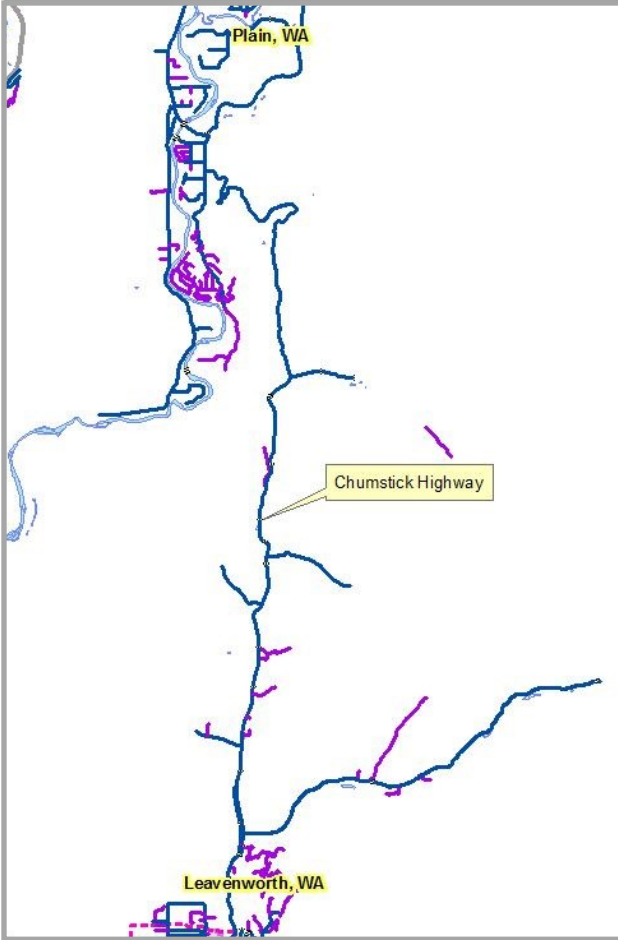




CRP 696: Chumstick Highway Safety Improvement

Project Number: County Road Project 696

Project Length: 12.26 miles

Basis for Project: Safety

Construction: Summer 2016—Spring 2017

Project Description: The purpose of the project is to improve traveler safety on the Chumstick Highway from Leavenworth to Beaver Hill (MP 0.11 to 12.37). The project will upgrade existing signs and install new signs. Six-inch wide edge lines will also be installed to improve roadway delineation.

Status: Signs will be installed beginning May 8, 2017. New fog and centerlines were painted in summer 2016.

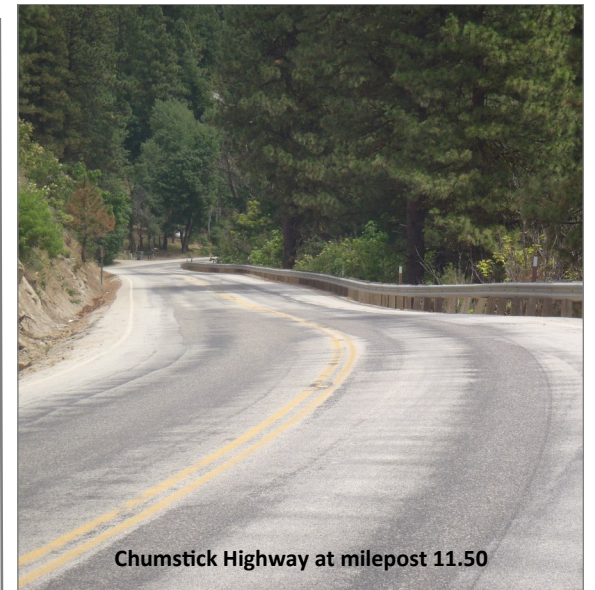
Traffic Impacts: During construction of the safety improvements, travelers can expect traffic control from flagger-controlled to pilot car-controlled in work zones.
