

Chelan County Solid Waste Brush Disposal

This disposal service is an effort to control forest insects and diseases, manage wildfire fuels and recycle wood fiber that would otherwise go to waste.

Trees and limbs (up to 12 inches in diameter) and brush will be accepted. No plastic bags, grass clippings, sod, root wads or noxious weeds are permitted.

Citizens are reminded that much of western Chelan County is under an apple maggot quarantine. State law prohibits brush from the quarantine area to leave a quarantine area. The

Dryden Transfer Station is located in a pest-free area; it does not accept yard waste from the quarantine area. A brush drop-off site is open

Fridays at the county's day pit area on East Leavenworth Road. The site is for residents and businesses in the apple maggot quarantine area.

Disposal Sites

Dryden Transfer Station

Cost: \$80 per ton (minimum fee for loads under 200 pounds is \$10)

Location: Off Highway 2/97, about 1 mile east of the "Big Y" interchange. Entry is only possible from eastbound lanes.

Hours: 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturdays

Leavenworth Drop-Off Site

Site is available to residents and businesses in the apple maggot quarantine area.

Cost: \$10 per cubic yard (minimum fee is \$10)

Location: County day pit at East Leavenworth Road, at the intersection of Icicle Road.

Hours: 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Fridays (closed November-March)

North Chelan Transfer Station

Cost: \$8 per cubic yard (\$5 minimum fee)

Location: 23235 Highway 97A, north of Chelan.

Hours: Summer operation hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturdays

Stemilt Organic Recycling Center

Cost: \$10 per cubic yard

Location: Located at 1465 S. Wenatchee Ave. in Wenatchee.

Hours: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturdays.

Entiat Chipping Site

Site is available to residents in the Entiat area.

Location: Off Highway 97A, behind the Columbia Breaks Fire Interpretive Center.

Hours: 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturdays

Leavenworth Recycling Site

Site is available to in-city residents only. No commercial hauls allowed.

Location: 1402 Commercial St., Leavenworth

Hours: 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturdays and 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. on Wednesdays.
