



Chelan County Solid Waste Brush Disposal

This disposal service is an effort to control forest insects and diseases, manage wildfire fuels and recycle wood fiber that would otherwise go to waste. Trees and limbs up to 12 inches in diameter and brush will be accepted. No plastic bags, grass clippings, sod, root wads or noxious weeds permitted. Located off Highway 2/97 approximately 1 mile east of the "Big Y" interchange. Entry is only possible from eastbound lanes.

Chelan Transfer Station \$8.00 Per Cubic Yard (\$5.00 Minimum Fee)

Located off Highway 97A north of Chelan.
