

City of Cashmere 2016-17 Collection Schedule

PLEASE POST

Please place containers at the curb by 6:00 a.m.

- Three (3) feet apart with lids opening toward street
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes
- Within 5 feet of the main road

Please remove containers as soon as possible after collection

Recycling collected on blue weeks on garbage day.

If collection falls on or after Thanksgiving (Nov 24), Christmas (Dec 25), or New Year (Jan 1), collection is **one day later** that week.

LOCAL RECYCLING RESOURCES

Some items such as medical wastes, fluorescent bulbs and tubes, needles, fuel tanks, electronics and chemicals are hazardous and are not allowed in garbage or recycling.


Plastic bags, cellphones, rechargeable batteries and other hard to recycle items may be accepted at various local stores near you. Search these sites to find a drop-off location near you!

RECYCLING

Place loose, clean recyclables into your blue recycling cart for easy sorting.

Do not bag!

All recyclables should be clean, empty and dry. **NO LIQUIDS**

Clean Paper

Mail, envelopes, newspaper, flattened cardboard, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper boxes (*cereal, etc.*), gift wrap



Paper Food Containers

Clean paper cups, milk cartons, juice boxes, frozen food boxes



Clean Glass

Glass bottles, jars (no caps)



Clean Metal

Aluminum & tin cans, scrap metal (no sharp or greasy metal) (*limit 2x2x2 ft, 35 lbs*)



Clean Plastic

Plastic cups, plastic bottles, jugs, round dairy tubs (no caps)



NO PLASTIC BAGS!



NOT ACCEPTED IN RECYCLING
No shredded paper, foam plastic trays, plates, utensils, mirrors, windows, dishes, ceramics, needles, syringes or toxic containers (auto products, pesticides, etc.).

RECYCLING TIPS

- Blue recycling carts are emptied **every-other-week**. (*see enclosed calendar*)

No cost for extra recyclables: There is no limit on extra recycling. Put extra recyclables in a clearly labeled kraft paper bag, cardboard box or 32-gallon container with handles and lid. Please label "Recycle."

GARBAGE

These items are not recyclable. Please put them in your grey garbage cart.

NO HAZARDOUS WASTE
Do not put hazardous or medical wastes, fluorescent bulbs or tubes, needles, liquids, fuel tanks, computers or TVs in garbage or recycling.

Non-recyclable plastic

Foam take-out containers, foam cups, foam packing peanuts, plastic lids, plastic utensils, prescription vials, diapers, motor oil containers, garden hoses, snack bag wrappers bows, ribbons, etc.



Non-recyclable glass

Window panes, mirrors, ceramics, dishware, light bulbs, broken glass, etc.



Non-recyclable paper

Paper towels, napkins, wrapping paper, etc.



Non-recyclable metal

Paint cans, lids, caps, sharp metal objects, plastic appliances, etc.



GARBAGE TIPS

- Always bag all garbage.
- Double bag pet waste, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust, and cold ashes.
- **Weight limit: 32-gal/65 lbs** for your collector's safety.
- **Garbage charges** are based on container size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed.
- Bulky items like mattresses, appliances, and building materials are not accepted at the curb. To find disposal or recycling options visit www.ecyclewashington.org or your local transfer station.
