The Cashmere Area offers the following as options for recycling:

*****Curbside Collection** – The city of Cashmere offers a bi-monthly curbside collection of recyclable goods. Recyclable materials should be placed next to standard waste receptacles and will be collected every other week during the regularly scheduled pickup of waste. If inclement weather (Rain or Snow) occurs on the day of a scheduled recycle pickup, please hold your recyclables until the next regular pickup day. There is no charge for this service. (This service is offered through the City of Cashmere, **NOT** through Waste Management)

River Street Recycling Center – The River Street Recycling Center offers a drop-off point for recyclable materials. The Recycle Center's hours are 12:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays. The River Street Recycling Center is located on the west end of River Street.

Dryden Transfer Station – The Dryden Transfer Station is another possible drop-off location for recyclable materials. The Dryden Transfer Station's hours of operation are: 9:30 a.m. – 5:00 P.M. Tuesday through Friday and 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. The Dryden Transfer Station can only be accessed from the eastbound lanes of highway 2.
