The Chelan/Manson area offers the following as options for recycling:

Various Drop-off Sites – The Chelan/Manson area offers several locations for dropping off materials to be collected by the North Chelan County Recycling Center. In Chelan, the drop-off site is located at Safeway in the gas station parking lot and in Manson, the drop-off site is located next to the Red Apple Market parking lot on Quetilquason Road (For GPS reference, the Red Apple Market is located at 610 E Wapato Way).

North Chelan Recycling Center – The North Chelan Recycling Center is available for dropping off numerous recyclable materials. The North Chelan Recycling center is open from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday. It is located near the Chelan Transfer Station.
