Typical waste collected: Drain and oven cleaners, wood strippers, paint thinner, gasoline, brake fluid, anti-freeze, engine and radiator fluids, transmission fluid, pesticides, herbicides, rodent killers, insect sprays, pool chemicals, cesspool cleaners, fertilizer, kerosene, bleaches, ammonia, sealants, rechargeable batteries, and oil-based paints.

NEW THIS YEAR! Latex and water-based paints WILL NOT be accepted at the events. When thickened with kitty litter or another absorbant material, water-based and latex paints can be dried and placed in your household garbage.
