The Leavenworth Area offers the following as options for recycling:

*****Curbside Collection** – The Leavenworth Area offers a bi-monthly curbside collection of recyclable goods. Recyclable materials should be placed inside the blue recycling receptacle provided by waste management.

Michelsen's Packaging – Michelsen's, located in Wenatchee, accepts numerous types of recyclable material. Michelsen's is located at 1105 Hawley Street, behind the Wenatchee Sav-Mart. For further information call (509) 663-6671.

Dryden Transfer Station – The Dryden Transfer station is another possible drop-off location for recyclable materials. The Dryden Transfer Station's hours of operation are: 9:30 a.m. – 5:00 P.M. Tuesday through Friday and 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. The Dryden Transfer Station can only be accessed from the eastbound lanes of highway 2.

Leavenworth Recycling Site — The Leavenworth recycling is another possible drop-off site for recyclables goods. The hours of operation are: 11:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. on Saturday and 4:30 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday. The site is located next to the Leavenworth Sewage Treatment Plant in Leavenworth. (For GPS reference, the Leavenworth Sewage Treatment Plant is located at 1402 Commercial St.) **This site is available to Leavenworth residents only.**
