



Chelan County Solid Waste Prescription Disposal

This disposal service helps curb illegal use of prescription drugs by providing a monitored drop-off location. The program also seeks to prevent people from flushing prescriptions down toilets or sinks, where they eventually enter wastewater and septic systems as pollutants. Call the Chelan County Sheriff's Office at 667-6851 for more info.

FREE drop-off disposal is available for the following: prescribed narcotics, prescription medications, over-the-counter medications, medication samples, pet medications, medicated ointments, **and** lotions, vitamins, inhalers **and** **unopened** EpiPens.

DROP-OFF LOCATIONS:

(during business hours only)

In Wenatchee: Chelan County Sheriff's Office, 401 Washington St. *(in the basement **of the justice center**)*

In Chelan: Chelan County Sheriff's Office, 207 N. Emerson St.

If you are unable to use one of these locations, mix your medicines with an undesirable substance, such as cat litter or used coffee grounds. Put **the mixture** into a container with a lid, concealing any personal information, and place the sealed container in the trash. Make sure your trash cannot be accessed by children, pets or **people** who **may** be looking in garbage for drugs.

PLEASE DO NOT FLUSH UNUSED DRUGS!
