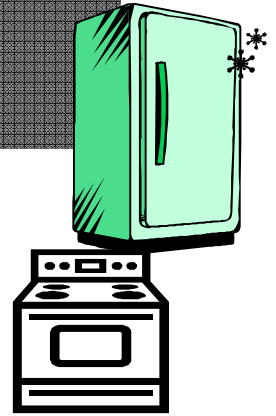


2009 Chelan County Clean-Up

Metal Recycling Events



Residents may recycle for free most unwanted large appliances and scrap metal, and for a minimal cost; tires and auto batteries at participating local businesses!

Wenatchee

Saturday April 4 at Lincoln City Park

7 a.m. – 3 p.m. Autos, Sprayers, and Refrigeration Units not accepted.

Malaga

Saturdays March 28 & April 4 off W. Malaga Rd in County Pit west of Malaga Fire Station, no unloading adjacent or near the station or training facilities.

8 a.m. – 3 p.m. Refrigeration Units, Sprayers & Automobiles **are** accepted.

Dryden

One Day Only—Saturday April 4 at Dryden Transfer Station, Hwy 2

9 a.m. – 4 p.m. Refrigeration Units, Sprayers & Automobiles **are** accepted.

Entiat

Saturdays March 28 & April 4, at City of Entiat Gravel Pit.

9 a.m.-3 p.m. Refrigeration units & Sprayers accepted here. Autos not accepted.

Chelan

Saturdays March 28 & April 4, at Rowe's Wrecking Yard;

9 a.m. – 4 p.m. Refrigeration Units, Sprayers & Automobiles **are** accepted.

- ⇒ There is a **\$20 fee for refrigeration units** that contain, or once contained coolants. Units will not be accepted if they contain any food.
- ⇒ **Tires & Auto Batteries:** take to TDS Tire Center on S. Wenatchee Avenue; Discount Tire at 1914 N. Wenatchee Ave. or Chelan's Les Schwab; Fees vary by style: \$2-3.00 charge for passenger tires, & an extra \$2-4.00 for tires on rims. Rims are not accepted. Auto batteries free at many battery retail locations, or up to \$2.00 each.
- ⇒ **Cars, motorbikes & trailers with titles** are accepted at the Dryden, Malaga and Chelan sites only. Orchard sprayers are also accepted at these sites, they must be well rinsed. Motorized units and sprayers must have fluids & tires removed. Tires may be removed at the site, but participants must take tires to an approved recycler. Contact the County Sheriff for lost titles, 667-6400.
- ⇒ **Orchard Sprayers** must be rinsed; tires removed at the collection site or prior to delivery.
- ⇒ **Qualified Disabled & Elderly** (not for those that have resources to hire an appliance recycler): For pick up of accessible appliances call March 24-25, Wenatchee area call 663-7421.

Don't Bring:

Propane bottles, fencing, wire, cable, televisions, computers, pressurized tanks, mattresses, light ballast, non-aluminum canopies, enclosed barrels & tanks, or garbage.
