## **WHAT'S NEW?**

In 2019 the Washington State Legislature made some changes to the Property Tax Reduction Program for Senior Adults and Disabled Persons that will take affect for the 2019 assessment year, which is what you pay taxes on in 2020. The two major changes are the maximum income limit and residency requirements.

### **Income**

The annual qualifying household combined disposable income limit is raised from \$40,000 to \$43,588 for Chelan County residents.

### **Residency**

The property must be your primary residence and you must occupy the home for at least 9 months each year, which is a change from the previous 6 month requirement.
