Minister/Officiant Information



Registry

No registration is required to perform marriage ceremonies in Washington State. You are not required to present credentials or notify the County.

Those Qualified to Perform a Ceremony

Marriage statutes specify that a qualifying officiant be any regularly licensed or ordained minister or any priest, imam, rabbi, or similar official of any religious organization. Additionally, judges as listed in <u>RCW 26.04.050</u>.

Minister Duties

- 1. Verify that the license is valid. Ensure that the date of marriage falls between the valid dates specified at the top of the Department of Health (DOH) Certificate of Marriage.
- Complete the Officiant section at the bottom of the form. Gather signatures of the couple, witnesses, and yourself.
 Use black ink only.
 - Tip Field 'Type of Ceremony' should be marked as religious when ceremony is performed by a minister of any type.
- 3. **Ensure** that all boxes in the officiant section of the DOH Certificate of Marriage have been completed.
- 4. Return the original signed certificate to this office promptly. Couples need to prove they are married in order to make changes to health coverage or legal name, so your promptness is appreciated.
- 5. The return envelope should already contain another envelope addressed to the couple. Add the completed DOH Marriage Certificate to the large envelope and return both to us.
- 6. **Retain the 'officiant copy'** of the marriage license for your records.
