Discussion

- Lake Chelan Wine and Jazz (Yes, \$10k)
 - Awarded \$33k (2023), Requesting \$50k (2024)
 - Taylor stated last year \$170 per ticket, asking for a lot of funds for a non-free event
 - Donated \$5k back to schools, net \$30k
 - \$169 +tax per ticket, 4 day all access festival pass. Kids 12 and under free.
- Manson Pickleball Tournament (Yes, but ask for reporting from 2023)
 - Eric -Wapato stated it did have some reservations, not as well of a turn out because it was against westside teams
 - Day events don't generate overnight stays
 - Awarded \$15k last year
- 2024 WA State Trails Conference (Yes)
 - Parameters for allowing conferences to use lodging tax
 - Yes, because it's a one-two punch
 - George abstains
- Caroling & Christmas in the Mountain Concerts (ask for clarification on funding)
 - Last year \$8k for new costumes
 - Small budget, small ask, huge reach, worthy cause
 - o Ask for clarification what the funds are for
- Cashmere Chamber of Commerce (Maybe)
 - Per last meeting, they are not interested in tourism
 - Ask them to come present marketing plan

- Cashmere Museum and Pioneer Village Festival (Yes)
 - Helps for people that want to know the history
- East West Classic (Yes, half the funds)
 - People will travel and spend money
- Experience Wine in WA's Paradise (Yes)
 - \circ $\$ Pay a fee in order to be part of it
 - Last year gave money to print wine maps
 - Awarded \$30k last year
- Family Lines Fly Fishing Academy (No)
 - It's a guide service, does not align with LTAC
- Greater Leavenworth Museum (Yes)
 - Increasing the amount of people going through
 - Troy abstains
- Haunted Manson (No)
 - Last year told them no because they felt it was a local event
 - Same this year, does not fit any different criteria
 - Not driving a lot of commerce for heads in beds
- Lake Chelan Arts Festival (Yes)
 - Very careful to follow rules
 - Turned in reporting timely
- Lake Chelan Bach Fest (Yes, half the funds)
 - o Most musicians are educators/teachers so July timeframe works best
 - Suggested to move to September
 - Embellishment for summer tourists already there
- Leavenworth & Cashmere Farmers Markets (Yes, with stipulations)
 - Going against LTAC by moving to busiest day and time in downtown Leavenworth, every Saturday from June-October
 - Conflicting with local businesses
 - Funding with stipulations work closely with Chamber
- Leavenworth International Accordion Celebration (Yes)
 - o Embellishment to summer activities
 - o Unique
- Leavenworth Spring Bird Fest (Yes)
 - People come from all over for this
- Leavenworth Summer Theater (Maybe)
 - Biggest challenge is the stage is being demolished
 - Appears non-profit is making money, doesn't appear to need funding
 - \circ $\;$ Commissioner Gering to ask for budget clarification $\;$
- Manson Apple Blossom Parade (No)
 - Fun, day event. Not producing heads in beds.
- Numerica PAC Marketing (Yes)
- Music in the Meadow Summer Concerts (Yes)
 - Opening up to many types of music

- Marketing and budget are clear, room to grow
- Chuck abstains
- Nature's Window Museum Archery Program (Maybe)
 - New building Ron will look into permits and fire marshal approval
 - Hold off until verify permits
 - Commissioner Gering will ask for clarification
- Rails & Ales (Maybe)
 - Bring them in to discuss plan
- Spring & Fall Wine Walks (No)
 - o 750 people, only 50 stay over night
- Stehekin Guidebook (Yes)
 - Made recommendations last year, no changes this year
 - Stehekin is busy, though people typically go for the day
- Tour de Bloom 2024 (Half)
 - During Apple Blossom
 - Bring spouses, kids and friends
 - Fund half and encourage to ask City of Wenatchee
- Two Rivers Medieval Faire (Yes, \$4351)
 - Held at a campground, Mother's Day Weekend
 - Awarded \$4k in 2022
- WA State Autumn Leaf Festival (Yes)
 - \circ $\;$ Travel to other areas to promote tourism to our area
 - \$15k last year
- Wenatchee First Fridays Marketing (No)
 - Local event
- Wenatchee River Bluegrass Festival (Yes)
 - Submitted reporting
 - Brings in a lot of people
- Wenatchee Valley Museum & Cultural Center (Yes)
 - Good job in break down of costs
