An application was submitted by Morgan Picton & Associates, agent, on behalf of Buck Fruit LLC, owner for a Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map and Zoning Map Amendment on approximately 118.69 acres of land. The proposal is to change the

designation from Rural Residential/Resource 5 (RR5) to Rural Residential/Resource 2.5 (RR2.5). The subject property is located at 1600 Lakeshore Drive, Manson, WA. The property is also identified by Assessor's Parcel # 282127609200.

Matt Hansen gives staff report on the application before the Board. The staff report presented to the Planning Commission is included in the information given to the Board of Commissioners. The Planning Commission heard the proposal on December 18, 2006 and forwarded a recommendation of approval with an 8-0 vote. The Planning Department feels that this application is in compliance with GMA.

Commissioner Hawkins discloses that he has had business dealings Buck Fruit but he does not feel that would affect his judgment in the matter. There are no objections from the public. Commissioner Goehner states that the property is in Chelan County Fire District #5 rather than the City of Chelan Fire District as in the information.

Morgan Picton, agent for the applicant, speaks on the matter. Mr. Picton offers an email correspondence by Alan Rehn. No other public comment.

Moved by Commissioner Walter, seconded by Commissioner Hawkins and carried that the Board approve the application for CPA 2006-028 and ZC 2006-028 based upon the findings of fact and conclusions of law with a resolution to follow on January 16, 2007 for signature.

An application was submitted by Morgan Picton & Associates, agent on behalf of Riley and Marianne Sivertsen, owner for a Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map and Zoning Map Amendment on approximately 11.16 acres of land. The proposal is to change the designation from Rural Residential/Resource 5 (RR5) to Rural Residential/Resource 2.5 (RR2.5). The subject property is located at 2248 Summit Blvd, Manson, WA. The property is also identified by Assessor's Parcel #s 282121610135 and 282121610145.

Cliff Wavra gives staff report which forwarded a recommendation of approval based upon the information provided to them and feels that it is consistent with GMA. The Planning Commission forwarded a recommendation of approval at the December 18, 2006 with a vote of 8-0 and findings of fact and conclusions of law. It is noted that this property also lies within the Chelan County Fire District No 5.

Morgan Picton speaks in favor of the application.

Ken Rau speaks on the application. He generally supports the change in designation but would like to make note to reference the Chelan County Zoning Code 11.14; and

requests the property owner complies with those regulations and does not change it for use as vacation rentals. No other public comment on the matter.

Moved by Commissioner Hawkins, seconded by Commissioner Walter and unanimously carried that the Board approve the application for CPA 2006-029 and ZC 2006-029 based upon the findings of fact and conclusions of law with a resolution to follow on January 16, 2007 for signature.

Commissioner Hawkins states that he has business dealings as well as community involvement with the applicants, Arnold and Melody Baker but does not feel that it would affect his ability to render an impartial decision in the matter. No objections are voiced by the public.

An application was submitted by Morgan Picton & Associates, agent on behalf of Arnold & Melody Baker, owner for a Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map and Zoning Map Amendment on approximately 10.13 acres of land. The proposal is to change the designation from Rural Residential/Resource 5 (RR5) to Rural Village (RV). The subject property is located at 1281 Totem Pole, Manson, WA. The property is also identified by Assessor's Parcel # 282135608375.

Cliff Wavra gives staff report. Planning Commission information packets have been forwarded to the Commissioners. Staff forwards a recommendation for denial primarily regarding parcel size and current development. They do not feel this meets the criteria and is not consistent with GMA. The planning Commission forwarded a recommendation of approval with a vote of six in favor and two opposed from their hearing on the matter which was held on Dec 18. The findings of fact and conclusions of law have been amended to reflect the outcome of the Planning Commission meeting.

Agent Mr. Morgan Picton speaks on the matter. He shows boundaries of the urban growth area lines which was set according to the topography of the land. The application for designation was submitted at the same time the neighboring property submitted their designation which was approved. Increased availability of housing is needed in the area in order to keep up with the growing population estimates. Approval of the project would help address the need for affordable houses in the area.

Arnold Baker, applicant speaks on the matter. This area is a community. He is a third generation farmer and has obtained other employment as well as the farming operations. He cannot farm on the property and cannot afford to continue paying tax on the land and would need to either sell it to a developer or develop it himself. He would like to develop it himself. Attracting working class and affordable housing is one of his goals. No other comments are given by the public.

Moved by Commissioner Walter, seconded by Commissioner Hawkins, and unanimously carried that based upon findings of fact and the amended conclusions of law, (noting that the fire district information is also amended as stated earlier) the application is approved with a resolution to follow on January 16, 2007 for signature. The aerial map shows the adjoining development in better detail which will be included within the resolution.
