## AGENDA:

I. CALL TO ORDER

II. PUBLIC HEARINGS

**CUPA 23-377 Selfs Motel – This matter was continued to the May 15th, 2024 hearing examiner meeting.** 

**AA 24-039 & 24-040 Rowe's Towing** - A request for an Administrative Appeal was submitted to appeal CE 22-0052 issued by Code Enforcement for operating a campground/campsite/trailer park without a conditional use permit. 620 George Road, Chelan, WA 98816; and identified by Assessor's Parcel No.: 27-23-19-616-020. — **Kirsten Ryles – STR manager/Assistant Director** 

Mr. Kottkamp discussed the application details and entered the staff report, application materials, site plans, public comments, and the entire planning staff file into record.

Chelan County Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Marcus Foster states he would like to have Deputy Anderson testify when appropriate.

Attorney Joan Mell, representing the appellant, addresses her objections to the procedures from the county for providing the records she and the appellant requested. She states that her client has not received accurate information in a timely manner in order to respond.

No comment was made by the public.
