From my 40 some years of hunting Elk and hunting Elk sheds experience on the 11 sections that I hike and hunt on, I have observed the habits of the Elk. In the spring time when the Bull Elk are in section 16 and 17 they stay on the south side of the canyons in section 16 and 17 in little benches about $\frac{3}{4}$ up the hill side so the sun is shining on them. When the Bull Elk are in section 16 and 17 they eat on the new green grass on the south side of the canyon in the spring. As it gets hotter the Bull Elk move to the North side of the canyons in section 16 and 17 to get shade and keep cool. The Bulls and cows move around a lot in the summer time going through sections 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22 and 23. The majority of the cow Elk normally do not get into 17 until after calving, most of the cow Elk do their calving in sections 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22 and 23.
