CHELAN COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 79-22

WHEREAS, much of the terrain of Chelan County is of a nature as to expose buildings to natural disasters such as floods, mud slides, and avalanches, rendering buildings sites unsafe; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 77-109 the Chelan County Commissioners did adopt the Uniform Building Code; Now, Therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CHELAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, as follows:

That Chelan County Resolution No. 77-109, the Uniform Building Code, be and is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section, to wit:


SECTION 3. The Building Director may deny a building permit for a structure which is proposed for a location which will be exposed to danger of serious damage from external causes such as floods, mud slides, and avalanches, provided, that this Resolution shall not obligate the Building Official to make inspection or inquiry as to the exposure of any proposed building site to such dangers nor does the issuance of permit express or imply any assurance that the building site is safe from such dangers.

This Resolution duly enacted by the Board of County Commissioners of Chelan County, Washington, this 20th day of February, 1979, and is effective immediately.
