



RESOLUTION 2021-01

LEVY RATES FOR 2022-2024

WHEREAS, the funds available for Manson Park & Recreation District through presently scheduled programs are insufficient to meet the needs of the District, and;

WHEREAS, Park Districts are authorized levies by a vote of the resident electors of the District, and;

WHEREAS, the necessary funds are not available through any other known source;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Manson Park & Recreation District, Chelan County, Washington, that an election will be held on the 27th day of April, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Manson Park & Recreation District found it necessary for the public welfare, health, and benefit, and in the best interest of the citizens of the District, to provide funds necessary for the day to day operations of the District;

"Shall Manson Park & Recreation District, Chelan County, Washington, authorize the County Commissioners of Chelan County to levy in the year 2021 as the regular levy to be collected in 2022, 2023, and 2024, approximately \$0.23 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for 2022, approximately \$0.23 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for 2023, and at a rate of approximately \$0.23 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for 2024, of the aforesaid District. The proceeds thereof to be placed in the Manson Park & Recreation District & the Wapato Lake Campground maintenance and operation funds of the aforesaid District?"

Which shall be submitted to the electors of said District for their approval or rejection in the form of the following Ballot Title:

"Will the Manson Park and Recreation District be authorized to impose regular property tax levies of \$0.23 or less per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for each of three consecutive years, 2022, 2023, and 2024?"
