

PROPOSITION NO. 1

BONDS TO REPLACE AND UPGRADE DETERIORATING SCHOOLS AND IMPROVE SAFETY

The Board of Directors of Lake Chelan School District No. 129 adopted Resolution No. 2025-03, concerning school improvements to provide safe facilities and enhance learning. This proposition would authorize the District to: build a new Morgen Owings Elementary School on property owned by the District; add ADA accessible health/fitness facilities and upgrade Career/ Technical Education shops to industry standards at Lake Chelan Middle/High Schools; improve the Mountain Goat Field Complex for student/ community use; issue \$73,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2025-03.
