Applications for new voter registrations or updates by mail, over the phone, email or online must be received by the Chelan County Elections Office no later than October 26, 2026.

Beginning October 27, voters registering or updating their existing registration in time for the November 3, 2026 General Election will need to appear in-person at any election's office no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 3. Chelan County Elections Office is located at 350 Orondo Ave., Level 3 Ste 306, Wenatchee.
