Notice of March 12, 2024 Presidential Primary

A Presidential Primary will be conducted in Chelan County on March 12. For this election only, you must mark and sign a party declaration on the return envelope for your vote to count. The major political parties require voters to mark a party box. If you mark the Democratic Party box, you must vote for a Democrat. If you mark the Republican Party box, you must vote for a Republican. Your selection will not affect how you may vote in future elections. Attempts to change the party declaration wording could result in your ballot not being counted. The following races will appear on the Presidential Primary ballot:
