Accessible Voting Units (AVU's) are available starting 18 days before an Election, until 8 p.m. on Election Day.

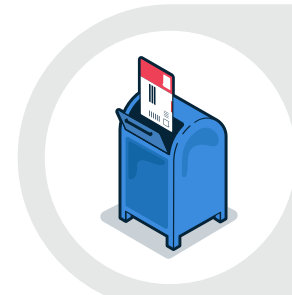
An AVU is a voting assistance unit that enables voters with visual impairments, cognitive/learning disabilities, illiteracy, or limited mobility to vote independently and privately"

# Manson School District No. 19

## PROPOSITION NO. 1 REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATION LEVY

The Board of Directors of Manson School District No. 19 adopted Resolution No. 11-28-22B, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State of Washington:

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Passage of Proposition No. 1 would allow Manson School District to replace an existing educational programs and operation levy that will expire at the end of calendar year 2023. The taxes collected by this replacement levy will be used to meet the educational needs of District students and pay expenses of educational programs and operations that are not funded by the State of Washington, including, but not limited to, pre-school classes, special education, nurses, counselors, safety upgrades, graduation readiness, athletics and extracurricular activities.

The proposed two-year replacement levy would authorize collection of taxes to provide up to \$1,884,500 in 2024 and \$1,955,326 in 2025. The tax levy rate required to produce these levy amounts is estimated to be \$1.11 in 2024 and \$1.04 in 2025 (estimated levy rate per \$1,000 of assessed value). The exact tax levy rates and amounts to be collected may be adjusted based upon the limitations imposed by State law at the time of the levy. Exemptions from taxes may be available to certain homeowners. To determine if you qualify, call the Chelan County Assessor at (509) 667-6365.
