Applications for new voter registrations or updates by mail, over the phone, email or online must be received by the Chelan County Elections Office no later than October 26<sup>th</sup>, 8 days before Election Day, November 3, 2020.

Beginning October 27<sup>th</sup>, voters registering or updating their existing registration in time for the November 3<sup>rd</sup> General Election will need to appear in-person at any election's office no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day November 3, 2020. Chelan County Elections Office is located at 350 Orondo Ave Level 3, Wenatchee.
