## RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 99 Subject: EMERGENCY DECLARATION BY ONE COMMISSIONER

**WHEREAS**, RCW 38.52.070 provides certain emergency powers and procedures to local jurisdictions and government officials to protect the health and safety of persons and property in the face of disaster, and;

WHEREAS, these powers may be exercised under this section in light of the exigencies of an extreme emergency situation without time-consuming procedures and formalities, and;

WHEREAS, the Chelan County Commissioners have concluded that requiring an official declaration of an emergency be made by a quorum of the Commissioners during session or a special meeting is a time consuming formality that is not in the best interest of County Citizens;

WHEREAS, any one of the three seated Commissioners of Chelan County, after receiving the counsel of Public Safety Officers' or Emergency Management Personnel, may proclaim that a state of emergency exists within Chelan County;

**WHEREAS**, On August 15, 2021 at approximately 5:17 p.m., a brush fire was reported near Shady Pass Campground, just outside Chelan;

WHEREAS, 123 homes are on Level 3 evacuation, 130 homes on Level 2 evacuation, and 54 homes on Level 1 evacuation. All residences west/up lake of Fields Point are at Level 3 evacuation status. All residences from Fields Point to Morning Sun Drive are at Level 2 evacuation status. All residences from Morning Sun Drive to Kelly's Resort are at Level 1 evacuation status.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Chelan County Commissioners hereby declare a disaster in Chelan County known as the 25 Mile Creek Fire of 2021;
