RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 141

A RESOLUTION of the Chelan County Flood Control Zone District adopting the 2022 District budget and authorizing improvements

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 86.15.140, on December 13, 2021 the Chelan County Flood Control Zone District ("District") held a public hearing on the proposed 2022 District budget, and

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Supervisors ("Board") desires to adopt the Districts 2022 budget, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2017-102, the Board adopted the District's initial comprehensive plan of development for flood and stormwater control, which is titled "Chelan County Flood Control Zone District Comprehensive Flood Hazard Management Plan" ("CFHMP") and is also referred to as the Comprehensive Plan of Development, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 86.15.110 and Section 3 of Resolution 2017-102, the Board must approve by resolution all flood control and stormwater control improvements, prior to the extension, enlargement, acquisition or construction of such improvements, and

WHEREAS, RCW 86.15.110 further provides that such approval resolution must state whether the improvements are to be extended, enlarged, acquired or constructed; state that the Comprehensive Plan of Development has been adopted; state that the improvements generally contribute to the objectives of the CFHMP; state that the improvements will benefit the county as a whole; state the estimated costs of the improvements; and identify the data supporting the estimated costs, and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to approve improvements in accordance with Section 3 of Resolution 2017-102;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE CHELAN COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Board hereby adopts the 2022 Budget for the District, as set forth in Attachments A (Work Plan), B (2022 District Budget), C (2022 Capital Improvement Projects Summary), and D (2022-2027 Capital Improvement Projects Summary).

Section 2. The Board approves the extension, enlargement, acquisition or construction, as applicable, of the improvements that are included in the Comprehensive Plan of Development and identified in Exhibits C and D to this Resolution, and determines that such improvements generally contribute to the objectives of the CFHMP and will be of benefit to the County as a whole.

<u>Section 3.</u> The estimated cost of the improvements are stated in Exhibits C and D to this Resolution, and the supporting data for the estimated cost is on file with the District Administrator.

<u>Section 4.</u> For improvements that will be constructed, preliminary engineering studies and plans either have been prepared or will be prepared, and have been filed or will be filed, with the District Administrator.
