


Recreation and Access Planning

Desired Future Opportunities

- Bird watching/wildlife viewing areas/opportunities.
- Interpretive signage for educational opportunity.
- Guided walks.
- Ski-in/bike-in/hike-in hut system for summer and winter use (ex: Rendezvous Hut System in Methow).
- Strategically increase parking at access points.
- Trail connections with USFS/WSDOT lands.
- River trail.
- More single track trail for linkages and making loops.
- Range of options (steep direct route to overlook, shorter easier routes for families).

Long-term Management Activities (11-20 Years)

- Identify funding for implementation and maintenance of desired improvements in recreation access and opportunity.
- Maintain partnerships with adjacent landowners to continue/improve recreation connections across the landscape.
- Assess and adaptively manage impacts of recreation on adjacent landowners and wildlife/aquatic resources.


Vision and Goals for Access and Recreation

Vision (developed by Stewardship Group):



Management goal for Recreation and Access (from the Community Forest Management Plan):







Coulter Block Lands Proximity to Nason Ridge Community Forest


2023 Restoration/Maintenance Projects

April: planting of 1,300 ponderosa and Douglas fir trees in floodplain and hillslope cutblock units on east side of Community Forest with ECY funding





May: Year 2 knapweed spray along perimeter road and decommissioned road areas




June: Rolling dips installed on perimeter road at location of erosion and plugged culvert, 40lb of native grass seed purchased with ECY funding






Nason Kahler Habitat Project

- ESA listed spring Chinook and steelhead spawning and rearing habitat improvement project
- Installation of ELJs (engineered logjams), floodplain restoration and road decommissioning
- Construction in Summer 2022 and 2023 with RCO Salmon Recovery Funding




Winter Warming Hut







Nasonview Forest Health Harvest



- Private property accessed through Community Forest
- DNR Cost-share grant funding covering pre-and post harvest mastication
- Thinning for fuels reduction and retention of desirable species
- Harvest managed by American Forest Management
- Logging contractor is under obligation to restore haul route to same or better condition

Access and Signage



- Gate installed prior to hunting season in fall 2023
- Location by tree island to prevent driving around the gate, wide area for parking
- Cleared by USFS for placement in current location
- Local concerns about gate placement
- Traffic counters will be installed in spring as part of monitoring plan

Additional Projects and Outings

- State Parks boom mower on xc groomed route- example of shared stewardship road maintanance
- May 10th Community Forest Coalition Nason Ridge site tour: 28 participants from Oregon and Washington
- Birding outings led by Tim and Mary Gallagher
- July 6th visit with C6 Biochar feasibility to assess stands for potential biochar feedstock/forest health treatments




2024 Workplan

- Complete Recreation and Access Supplement
- Develop fuels reduction/forest health units with funding from DNR and NRCS, Nason watershed NEPA process
- Priority Recreation and Access projects
 - Trail connections from Nason Ridge Trail, delineate Nason Ridge Trail at top of ridge intersection
 - Continue to improve signage
 - Work with Butcher Creek/Rd 6910 residents on gate placement and road maintenance
 - Sno-park feasibility
- Carbon financing feasibility
- Kahler Creek restoration design
