Type 3	25	50,000	<p>TYPE 3 Legal Truck</p> <p>3 Axle Vehicle Gross Weight = 60 k</p>
<p>The Type 3 legal vehicle is a three axle single-unit vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of 50,000 LBS (25 tons).</p>			
Type 3-S2	36	72,000	<p>TYPE 3S2 Legal truck</p> <p>5 Axle Vehicle Gross Weight = 72 k</p>
<p>The Type 3S2 legal vehicle is a five axle semi-tractor and trailer combination with a gross vehicle weight of 72,000 LBS (36 tons).</p>			
Type 3-3	40	80,000	<p>TYPE 3-3 Legal Truck</p> <p>6 Axle Vehicle Gross Weight = 80 k</p>
<p>The Type 3-3 legal vehicle is a six axle combination of a single-unit vehicle pulling a loaded trailer with a gross vehicle weight of 80,000 LBS (40 tons).</p>			
SHV (SU4)	27	54,000	<p>SU4 Truck GVW = 54 kips</p>
<p>SU4 is a four axle vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of 54,000 LBS (27 tons).</p>			
SHV (SU5)	31	62,000	<p>SU5 Truck GVW = 62 kips</p>
<p>SU5 is a five axle vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of 62,000 LBS (31 tons).</p>			
SHV (SU6)	34.75	69,500	<p>SU6 Truck GVW = 69.5 kips</p>
<p>SU6 is a six axle vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of 69,500 LBS (34.75 tons).</p>			
SHV (SU7)	38.75	77,500	<p>SU7 Truck, GVW = 77.5 kips</p>
<p>SU7, which is a seven axle vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of 77,500 LBS (38.75 tons)</p>
