In order to be considered for award the sealed bid must contain all forms fully completed, signed and submitted together as the Bid Proposal Package prior to the time of bid opening.

DATE OF OPENING BIDS

Sealed bids are to be received at the following location prior to the time specified.

At the Board of Chelan County Commissioners, 400 Douglas Street, Wenatchee, Washington 98801 until **9:30 a.m.** of the bid opening date.

The bid opening date for this contract is **May 19, 2020**. Bids received will be publicly opened and read after 9:30 A.M on this date.

Each bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Board of Chelan County Commissioners, 400 Douglas Street, Wenatchee, Washington 98801, and shall be marked "**BRUSH GRINDNG AT MULTIPLE SITES**" on the outside of the bid envelope.

RIGHT TO REJECT BIDS

Chelan County reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals, to accept the proposal or proposals deemed best for the County, or to advertise for new proposals, when, in the opinion of the Board of Chelan County Commissioners, the best interests of the County will be promoted thereby.

BID EVALUATION

In evaluating bids, the following criteria, in addition to price, quality and delivery, will be considered:

- 1. Past performance record of the bidder.
- 2. Experience, technical qualifications, skill, ability and capacity of the bidder.
- 3. Proximity of base office and shop.
- 4. Compliance with terms and conditions contained in the contract documents.
- 5. Equalizing elements or factors not specifically listed herein, in addition to that of price which would offset the final cost to, and the benefits to be derived by the County.
- 6. Qualifications and eligibility of the bidders to receive an award of the contracts under applicable laws and regulations.

TERMS:

Prices may not vary up or down from the original bid price.

All bids must state a firm price including all applicable Local, State, and Federal Taxes.

No penalty shall be involved for delays caused by acts of God, governmental action, accidents or other causes beyond the contractors control.

Chelan County reserves the right to use an alternate vendor in the event it is determined that problems develop resulting in the untimely work product.

PREPARATION OF PROPOSAL:

Chelan County will only accept proposals properly executed on physical forms it provides.

All prices shall be in legible figures (not words) written in ink or typed, and expressed in U.S. dollars and cents. The proposal shall include:

- 1. A unit price for each item (omitting digits more than four places to the right of the decimal point),
- 2. An extension for each unit price (omitting digits more than two places to the right of the decimal point),
- 3. The total Contract price (the sum of all extensions),
- 4. Any correction to a bid made by interlineation, alteration, or erasure, shall be initialed by the signer of the bid.
- 5. The Bidder shall make no stipulation on the Bid Form, nor qualify the bid in any manner.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Brush Griniding

Description

The work consists of grinding approximately 3,500 CY of brush at Chelan Transfer Station, 2,250 CY of brush at Dryden Transfer Station and 3,750 CY of brush at the East Leavenworth Pit, in Chelan County, in accordance with these special provisions and standard specifications.

Construction Requirements

The successful contractor shall furnish the labor, tools and equipment necessary to safely process, and stockpile chip piles on site at all three locations. The Contractor is only responsible to chip the current pile upon mobilizing onto site. Once work has started on the existing pile, the new pile created will not be part of this contract. The brush piles consist of trees (maximum size 26" width x 8'), brush, grasses, leaves, needles, florals, garden items, and other miscellaneous organic debris.

The Contractor shall accommodate the public by allowing a safe zone for the unloading of brush while the contractor works. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing safety netting/ screen, or temporarily halting operations, or other safety methods to prevent debris from the grinding/ chipping operations from becoming airborne and a potential hazard.

Processing of brush must be in accordance with all federal, state and local laws. Chips may be left on site in organized piles no taller than 6 foot high, out of the way of access to the site. At the Contractor's option, chips may be removed from the site and utilized at no additional cost to the Chelan County. The Contractor shall assume all responsibility for the materials once it leaves the site. Prior to removal the Contractor shall submit the intended location, where they plan to haul the chips for approval from the Chelan County.

The brush at the East Leavenworth Day Pit was generated within the Apple Maggot Quarantine Area and must stay within the quarantine area. Under no circumstance shall the chips from the East Leavenworth Day Pit be allowed to leave the Apple Maggot Quarantine Area. A map of the quarantine area is inserted as **Appendix A** of this document. A statewide searchable map is available at:

The Contractor will be responsible for keeping the sites secure by locking the gates during non-working hours and restricting public when the facility is closed. The Contractor shall be responsible for maintaining adaquete fire safety provisions and equipment. The contractor shall submit a Fire Prevention Control and Countermeasures Plan in accodance with WSDOT Standard Specifications 1-07.3(1)A.

Site shall be left in a clean and accessible manner. All refuse generated by the contractor shall be cleaned up and properly disposed

Working hours are from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. No other days or times will be permitted without the consent of Chelan County. The Contractor shall request a variance to the days and/ or time, 48 hours in advance.

Work shall be completed within 30 days calendar days from contract execution. It is anticipated that contract execution will occur within three (3) weeks following the bid opening.

The Contractor shall obtain and keep in full force during the term of this agreement, commercial general liability and property damage insurance, commercial umbrella liability insurance, and employer's liability (stop gap) insurance, with companies or through sources approved by the State Insurance Commissioner pursuant to Title 48 RCW. The amount of coverage shall be not less than \$1,000,000.00 for bodily injury, including death, to any one person and subject to that limit for each person, of not less than \$1,000,000.00 for each occurrence, except employer's liability (stop gap) insurance shall have a limit of not less than \$500,000.00 per occurrence for bodily injury or disease. Certificates of Insurance shall be provided to County with the signed Agreement.

Measurement

No specific unit of measurement shall apply to the lump sum item Brush Chipping. Informational estimated quantities have been provided. The contractor shall be responsible for verifying quantity.

Payment

"Brush Grinding", lump sum

The lump sum Contract payment shall be full compensation for all costs incurred by the contractor in performing the Work as defined in these specifications.
