




CRP 684: Chumstick Highway, Phase IV


Basis for Project: Maintenance

Construction Began: August 25, 2014

Project Description: This project is the fourth phase that will improve Chumstick Hwy (93350), which is classified as a Rural Major Collector (FFC 07) located in Chelan County, Washington. It is a vital link that serves residential, recreational, tourism, and agricultural traffic to the state parks, US forest land and communities of Leavenworth and Plain. The primary purpose of this project will improve the roadway structure to prevent future deterioration of the existing roadway. In addition to preservation and increasing the pavement structure, the project includes spot safety, clear zone and other improvements. This project will involve roadway pulverization and paving from MP 3.76 to MP 5.15.

Status: Project is complete.
