




CRP 654: Stemilt Loop Road, Phase II


Basis for Project: Road Improvement

Construction: Summer 2011

Project Description: Stemilt Loop Road Full-Depth Reclamation, Phase II, continued preservation work started in 2010. Full Depth Reclamation (FDR) is a pavement rehabilitation technique in which the full flexible pavement section and a predetermined portion of the underlying materials are uniformly crushed, pulverized or blended, resulting in a stabilized base course. This process was successfully used on Stemilt Loop in 2010 and this phase of the project, completed in 2011.

Notes: Phase III is in development and will complete the rehabilitation of this route.

Status: Complete (40 Working Days)
