

Chelan County Bridges: Overweight Load Truck Permit Process

TIP:
The sooner you get your application in, the more time we have to work with you.

Determine Your Route

Does this route use any Chelan County (unincorporated) bridges?

Does your truck need/have a WSDOT overweight load permit or exceed legal loads?

Does the route use any load-limited Chelan County bridges? See List of Restricted Bridges

Does your truck exceed the posted load limits and/or have a different axle layout?

No Chelan County permit required.

A Chelan County permit is required.

Chelan County Public Works processes the permit forms and forwards to the Bridge Engineer.

Bridge Engineer performs review and analysis:
1) A minimum of **7 working days** is needed to evaluate and perform analysis if bridge and truck combination has not been analyzed.
2) If bridge and truck combination have been analyzed before, a minimum of **3 working days** is necessary to check for changes in bridge condition since the previous analysis.

County Road Engineer or delegate reviews permit.
