

#### Sunnyslope Background

- The Knowles Road improvement project is an important project for the Sunnyslope area.
  - A land use forecast for the Sunnyslope area project shows use will double in the next 20 years.
- The current roadway does not sufficiently serve the developing area.
  - Roadway is narrow and lacks pedestrian and bike facilities.
- The Knowles project will be done in two phases, improving safety and mobility and improving work commutes and access to nearby Sunnyslope Elementary School.
- Improvements also are needed to correct ongoing drainage issues that damage the road's surface and shoulders.

#### Project Overview

- The project has been awarded a nearly \$1.4 million grant from the state Transportation Improvement Board's Urban Arterial Program. It will also be paid for with local county road funds and Chelan County Stormwater funds.
- The first phase of the project is from School Street to American Fruit Road and includes the American Fruit and Knowles roads intersection. The second phase of the project, which is not yet funded and does not have a start date, will be above American Fruit Road.






#### Key Design Components

The project will improve roadway safety for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists. It also will improve the road structure, allowing for a smoother ride and a shared, multi-use shoulder.

## Storm and Flood Control Feature



A detention pond will be constructed in the natural drainageway.

It is designed to treat stormwater runoff from the roadway. In addition to the roadway, it has a flood control zone element and has been sized to mitigate water runoff from the Sunnyslope Basin. Infrastructure planned to additional offsite storm water runoff.

#### Gravity Retaining Wall



~800 linear feet in Fill (westside) Typically 4' to 8' high, with Pedestrian rail/Sidewalk above

### Project Status

- Currently ~75% Design Phase
- Advertisement for bids Winter 2021
- Construction to commence in Spring/Summer 2022
  - ► Construction is expected to take ~10 weeks.
  - Prior to construction, people may see some work, such as the relocation of utilities.
  - During construction, the road will be at one lane, with flaggers directing traffic.
  - A detour for a portion of the project is being considered. The benefits include speeding up the work and minimizing impacts.
  - Another Open House will be scheduled prior to construction, with more information on public impacts (Spring 2022).


#### Other Improvements

- PUD water main to be replaced
- City to install new sewer main

#### Chelan County PUD - Waterline

- Chelan PUD is planning to replace approximately 1,400 feet of existing 4-inch steel water main with approximately 2,200 feet of new 8-inch ductile iron main.
- The timing of the project is well suited for replacement of the steel water main which is at the end of its useful life.
- The new 8-inch main will increase capacity and reliability of the water system in the area.
- The project also includes installing four new fire hydrants and replacing six customer connections.
- Water outages will be required for connections of the new main to the existing main and for connecting customer service lines from existing to new meter chambers.
- Affected customers will be notified of scheduled outages 24 to 48hours in advance of when the outage will occur.
