

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 42**  
**RE: Rescinding Resolution 2017-41**  
**Disposal Charges for Dryden Transfer Station**

**WHEREAS**, the rates for the Dryden Transfer Station are in need of updating for all wastes to coincide with the increased cost of disposal at the Greater Wenatchee Regional Landfill; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of operations and maintenance has increased, where the facility requires upgrades to include resurfacing the existing pit, constructing a second loading floor, repairing the pump house and replacement of equipment. The increase in rates shall provide the necessary means to continue the operations of a safe facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Solid Waste Plan (Local S.W.P.) rate is provided at \$2.00 per ton, and \$.50 per minimum load to be assessed for the County financing of the local solid waste plan programs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the following rates are increased as a result of operation costs at the transfer station and shall be exclusive of the Washington State refuse collection tax. The disposal fees at the Dryden Transfer Station shall be amended as follows and will become effective the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June, 2019, and

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 47**

RE: Disposal Charges for North Chelan Transfer Station and  
Rescinding Resolution No. 2017-40

**WHEREAS,** the Board of County Commissioners did enter into an agreement on January 30, 2017, for transfer station disposal rates and charges at the Chelan Transfer Station, and

**WHEREAS,** Chelan County entered into an agreement with Waste Management for the disposal of solid waste and has incurred an increase in disposal costs according to the past consumer price index (cpi) of three percent (3%) each year, and therefore require an increase of the minimum fee for municipal solid waste of \$.58, to base \$12.47 per minimum fee, and

**WHEREAS,** the brush collection and chipping program are in need of improved equipment, funds for maintenance and repairs, and where past costs incurred are an additional \$6.00 per cubic yard, as a total fee of \$14.00 per cubic yard of brush, and

**WHEREAS,** the rate increases caused for the processing and maintenance of the minimum loads of brush and yard debris increased by \$3.00 per cubic yard, for the total minimum of \$8.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the following rates, which are exclusive of County surcharge, and the Washington State refuse collection tax. The disposal fees at the North Chelan Transfer Station shall be amended as follows effective 1st day of June, 2019.
