



Wenatchee Valley Regional Decant Facility

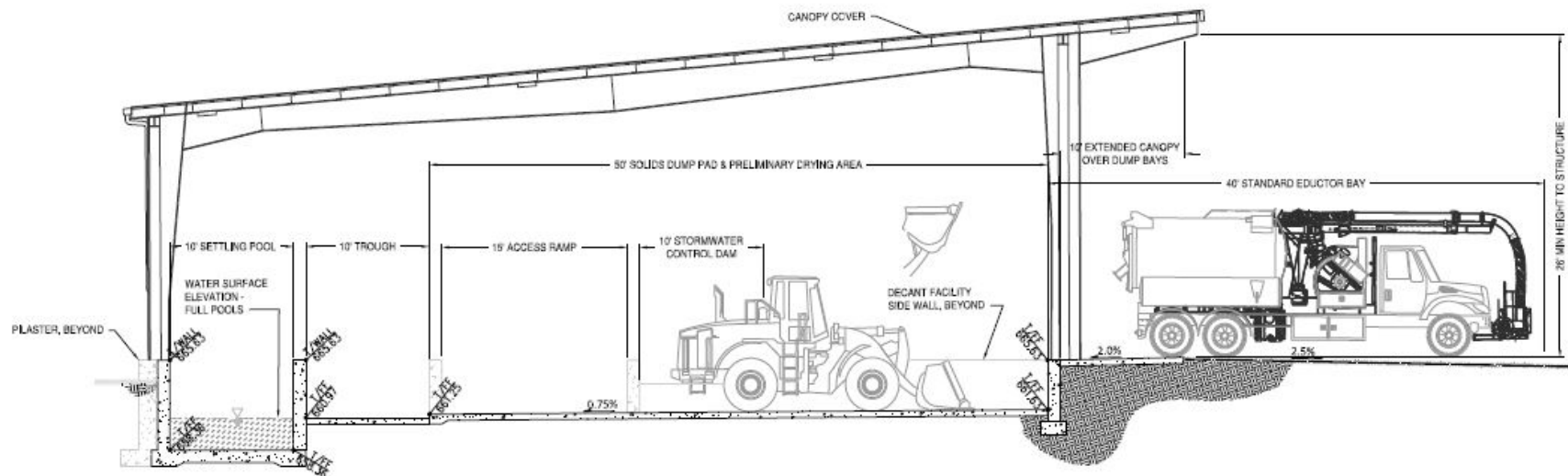

Project Details: The Wenatchee Valley Regional Decant Facility will be operated cooperatively with Chelan County, and the cities of Wenatchee and East Wenatchee. The mission of the Wenatchee Valley Regional Decant Facility is to provide an efficient and environmentally sound system for handling, treating, and disposing of stormwater liquids and solids generated from the cleaning of stormwater systems (catch basins, ponds, swales, street sweeping, etc.). Material brought to the facility will be decanted and allowed to dry. Dried material will either be disposed of at the landfill, or as allowed, for other subsurface filling activities. The regional partners expect to process approximately 3,600 tons of dried material per year. The facility is accessed from the east side of South Wenatchee Avenue near the intersection with Terminal Avenue.

The project was awarded to KRCI Construction with a bid of \$1,313,000.
