

Arrest Made in Leavenworth Vehicle Prowls

Chelan County Sheriff Mike Morrison reports, on 5/22/25, at about 11pm a Chelan County Deputy was flagged down by a citizen while they were driving through the parking lot of the Safeway in Leavenworth, WA.

The citizen advised the deputy that her bicycle had been stolen out of the back of her truck. The deputy took the report which included a detailed description of the stolen bicycle was well as a photograph of one similar. The bicycle was distinct in it's color and accessories.

Later on, 5/22/25, deputies were dispatched to a vehicle prowl in progress in the area of 8th and Commercial St in Leavenworth, WA. Deputies arrived in the area and located two suspects based off the description given by RiverCom. The deputies noticed that one of the suspects was riding the stolen bicycle. The two were detained.

Through the investigation the bicycle was confirmed as the stolen one. The two suspects also had multiple stolen items in their possession from several other car prowls as well.

Marque Wilson, a 26 year old female out of Coulee Dam and Phillip Quandrell Green Jr, a 32 year old male from Wenatchee, were arrested and booked into the Chelan County Regional Justice Center for possession of stolen property 2nd degree.
