Disposal of household hazardous waste at the Moderate Risk Waste Facility is available to any resident of Chelan County. A \$10 donation is recommended.

- ✓ Don't mix products.
- ✓ Keep products in original containers when possible. Label products not in original containers.
- ✓ Secure products so they don't tip over or leak.
- ✓ Containers should be nonleaking and of 5 gallons or less in size.
- ✓ Transport similar products upright in cardboard boxes for safe, easy unloading.
- ✓ Stay in your vehicle during unloading.
- ✓ 50-gallon limit per visit. Have more? Call to make an appointment so we can assist you.

gasoline/diesel	road flares
household cleaners	rechargeable batteries
household batteries	spray paint
hobby chemicals	pool & spa supplies
