We want your stay to be enjoyable. These rules are both ours and those of regulatory agencies that govern the park.

WE ASK YOUR COOPERATION IN THE FOLLOWING:

PARK INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

Parents: This is a family park. Please remember that parents are responsible for their children's conduct at all times.

Parking: The park has paved interior roads and parking pads. Do not drive or park any vehicle **on the grass**. Visitors must park in one of the visitor parking lots. **One vehicle per site.**

Dry Camp: WE HAVE A DESIGNATED DRY CAMP AREA. ABSOLUTELY NO TENTS OF ANY KIND ALLOWED IN THE PARK.

Safety: Clotheslines and dog runs are not allowed in campground.

Garbage: Do not leave unburned trash in fire pits. Place garbage in plastic bags with ties to eliminate odors and insects and place in covered receptacles at locations marked on the park map.

Behavior: No person shall indulge in offensive, profane, threatening or indecent conduct or language. Intoxicated persons will be evicted.

Visitors: Visitors are not allowed in the campground area without obtaining permission from the office. Visitors must leave the park by 10 p.m. Your visitors are your responsibility. Please be sure they observe the park rules. Guests **MUST** park in overflow parking.

Hours: Park hours are from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m., April 1 through Oct. 31. After Labor Day the Office will close at 8 p.m.

Pets: Pets are welcome, provided they are kept on a leash at all times. **If you leave the park, take your pet with you. You must clean up after your pets.**

Any infraction of these rules will be grounds for eviction. No refunds.
